The Philippine Association of Meat Processors Inc (PAMPI) noted the number of slaughter houses and accredited facilities has increased up to 10 percent per annum, driven by a growing population. Over the past five years, Filipino's per capita consumption of meat has increased to 15 kg for pork, which according to the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), is over two kg more than world's average pork consumption. During the same period, per capita consumption has increased from 10 to 14 kgs for chicken and two kgs for beef.
