As such, DA, DTI launch online platform that connects farmers to buyers, Deliver-E launched in Philippines, South Korea funds "smart" agri projects in Iloilo and Bukidnon, Agriculture Secretary William Dar aims to transform Philippine agriculture into a competitive industry that have "smart farms" with vast scientific and technological applications from the Fourth Industrial Revolution (Industry 4.0). PH executives continue investing in digital transformation. The Philippines has been named the top "digital riser" in East Asia and the Pacific by the European Center for Digital Competitiveness (ECDC).



he Philippines is a country with a population of more than 110 million people. It is forecasted to reach 125 million in 2030 according to World Population Review. The size of its population has led to a huge demand for animal products which boosts the livestock production sector to grow.

hilippines also witnesses a significant recovery of its swine industry with some provinces stated ASF Free. In August 2021, the Department of Agriculture reported the decline of active cases of ASF to less than 1% since the outbreak in 2019. A PHP 29.6 billion worth project was launched by the government to help the local hog raisers recover from the pandemic and re-produce 440,563 breeders and 10.5 million finishers, which can benefit around 115,800 pig farmers by 2023. The project aims to repopulate pig production and strengthen biosecurity in order to control the spread of the ASF.

The Philippines has been known as one of the top exporters of aquaculture yields in Asia. In 2nd quarter of 2021, most of the aquaculture farms harvested 585.48 thousand metric tons which are higher compared to the same quarter in 2020. Among all the fisheries subsectors, aquaculture has the biggest contribution of 50.9%. The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources under the Department of Agriculture continues its projects and programs for the livelihood of the fishermen and to ensure food security in the Philippines even in the middle of the COVID-19 pandemic.













hilippines is one of the fastest growing meat consuming nations in the world. The increase in demand for various animal products & higher value quality foods such as processed meat, eggs, organic milk & dairy products and other non-food items, has led to the growth in the usage of feed additives, boosting the market for feed additives in the country. This also has created an opportunity for feed manufacturers to enhance animal productivity.

n 2021, Philippines' chicken per capita consumption is estimated at 15.8 kg. The country's chicken consumption has steadily increased from 2013 to 2019 as it became the second most consumed protein after fish. Despite of COVID-19 pandemic, it is expected that chicken consumption will resume its steady rise as a protein source and benefit from the reopening of the economy in 2022.

The Philippines itself must import meat including pork, chicken & beef to fulfill the domestic demands. The country needs to boost farm production itself. As a result, we can expect a huge demand for equipment & machines.


