# Arrival and Quarantine Guidelines

## for Foreign Nationals Traveling to the Philippines

(These guidelines are subject to change depending on government advice)



#### Eligibility

Fully vaccinated international traveler from visa and non-visa required countries.

(No longer required to undergo facility-based quarantine)



### **Required Documents**

- O1 Valid passport for at least 6 months.
- 02 Visa (for visa-required countries).
- Letter of invitation or any proof of participation to the
- 04 Certificate of Vaccination
  - Received the 2nd dose in a 2-dose series or a single dose vaccine.
  - Vaccine is included in the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) Lost or Compassionate Special Permit (CSP) issued by the FDA, or
  - ► Emergency Use Listing of the World Health Organization.
  - ▶ The proof of vaccination must be either from:
    - \* World Health Organization International Certificate of Vaccination and Prophylaxis; or
    - \* VaxCertPH; or
    - \* National/state digital certificate of the country government which has accepted VaxCertPH under a reciprocal arrangement; or
    - \* Other proofs of vaccination permitted by the IATF.
- Foreign nationals that are not vaccinated must show Negative COVID-19 Test Result: RT-PCR Test should be taken within 48 hours prior departure; or Laboratory-based Antigen Test should be taken within 24 hours prior departure.
- O6 Valid tickets for return journey.
- One Health Pass.
- Travel insurance with COVID-19 coverage is not required but highly encouraged.

#### Steps



#### Before Your Flight

Obtain a negative RT-PCR test result (taken within 48 hours) or a negative Laboratory-based Antigen test result (taken within 24 hours) if you are not vaccinated.

- Register to Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) One Health Pass (www.onehealthpass.com.ph/e-HDC) at least 24 hours before your departure, and declare your personal information, health status, and travel history in the Bureau of Quarantine e-Health Declaration Card (e-HDC).
- Make sure to save a copy of your unique transaction number and One Health Pass QR code.
- Prepare other documents like confirmed booking at a hotel accredited by the tourism and health agencies.

#### During Your Flight

Complete the Bureau of Customs Form and Arrival Card.



#### **Upon Your Arrival**

- Of Proceed at the Department of Transportation One-Stop-Show (OSS) to undergo a temperate check, and present your BOQ One Health Pass QR Code, and proof of vaccination.
- Proceed to immigration to submit arrival card for clearance.
- OB Submit the Bureau of Customs Form with Customs Check and claim your baggage.
- Once cleared, you may proceed to your hotel to undergo self-monitoring for any symptom.

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If you develop any COVID – 19 symptoms during your stay, please immediately inform the hotel you are staying in or contact the Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) for further instructions and health protocols.
